Units

▣ There are four attributes of Unit

1. Units

- A length value is formed by + or – followed by number ,followed by two-letter abbreviation
- Ex : px It means pixels

2. Color units

- It is a keyword or numerical RGB specification
- There are 16 keywords like black,green,red,purple,etc

3. URLs:

- ▣ It represents address of the website .
- ▣ They may be quoted in single quote or double quote
- ▣ Ex: BODY{background:url(tiger.gif)}

4. Percentage Units :

- It is formed by + or - followed by number ,followed by % sign
- There are no spaces in percentage value

Class Attributes

- ▣ It allows you to style items within same HTML element differently
- ▣ A class always start with a dot which is followed by class name.
- ▣ The style is defined in the curly braces and contains the style property and value
- ▣ Ex:<p class="right">

This paragraph will right align</p>

ID Attributes

- ▣ They are similar to classes
- ▣ Except that once a specific id has been declared it cannot be used again within the same HTML file
- ▣ It is assigned by using indicator '#' to precede a name
- ▣ Ex : `<P ID="IS">`
