Event Driven Programming


- VB is an event driven programming language
- In VB, programming is done in graphical environment
- "An event is an activity that occurs during program execution such as mouse click or keypress"
- VB programs are built around events

- TextBox control supports various controls suh as Change, Click, MouseMove and other events
- The Click event fires when TextBox is clicked
- The MouseMoe event fires when mouse is moved overTextBox

- It is called integrated because we can access virtually all the tools that we need from one screen called interface


Visual Basic 6.0 Window
