# Event Driven Programming

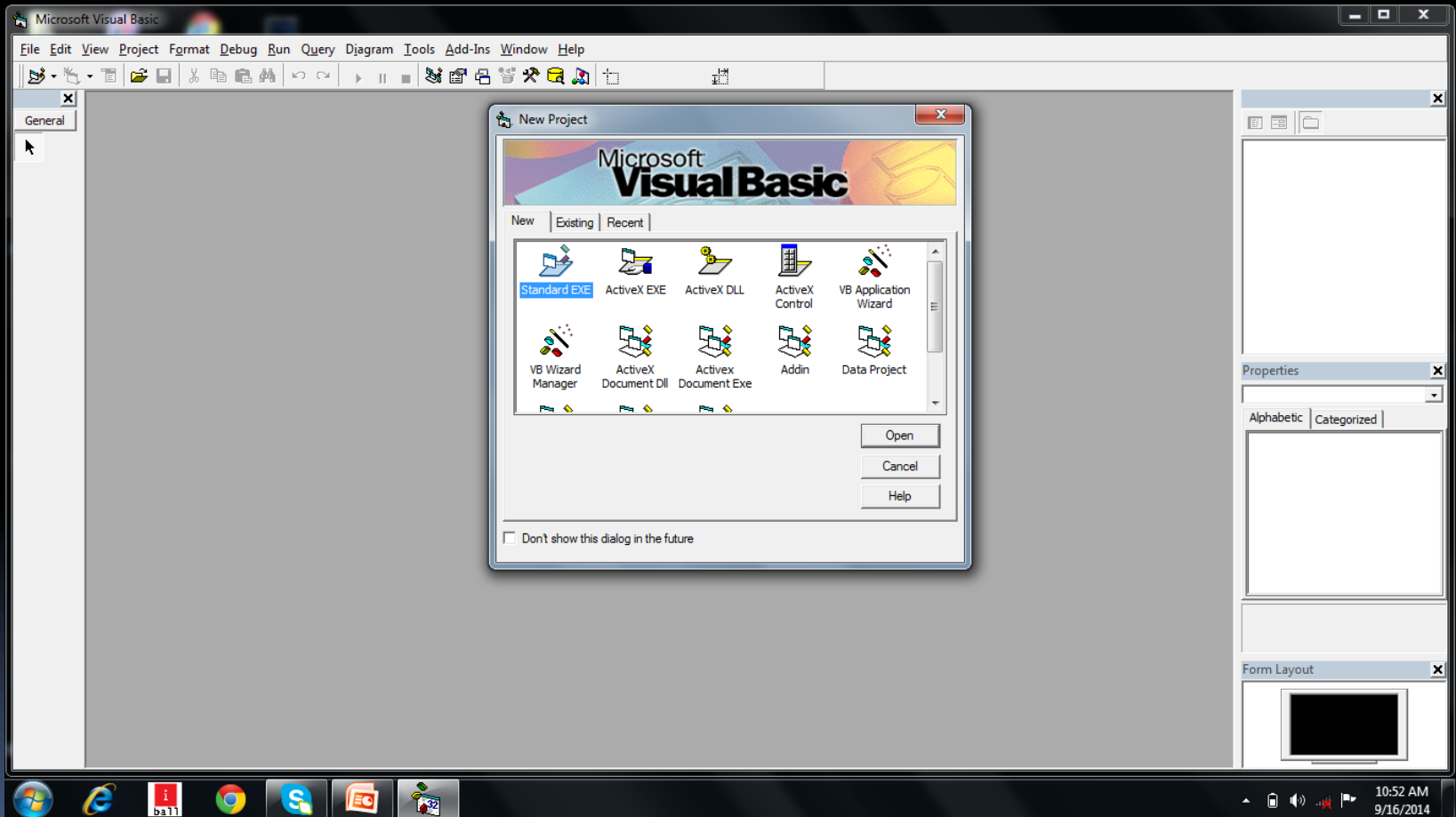
- VB is an event driven programming language
  - In VB, programming is done in graphical environment
  - “An event is an activity that occurs during program execution such as mouse click or keypress”
  - VB programs are built around events
-

- TextBox control supports various controls such as Change, Click, MouseMove and other events
  - The Click event fires when TextBox is clicked
  - The MouseMove event fires when mouse is moved over TextBox

# VB IDE(Integrated Development Environment)

- Before we can use VB we have to install VB 6.0
- IDE is used in programming world to describe the interface and environment we are using
- It is called integrated because we can access virtually all the tools that we need from one screen called interface

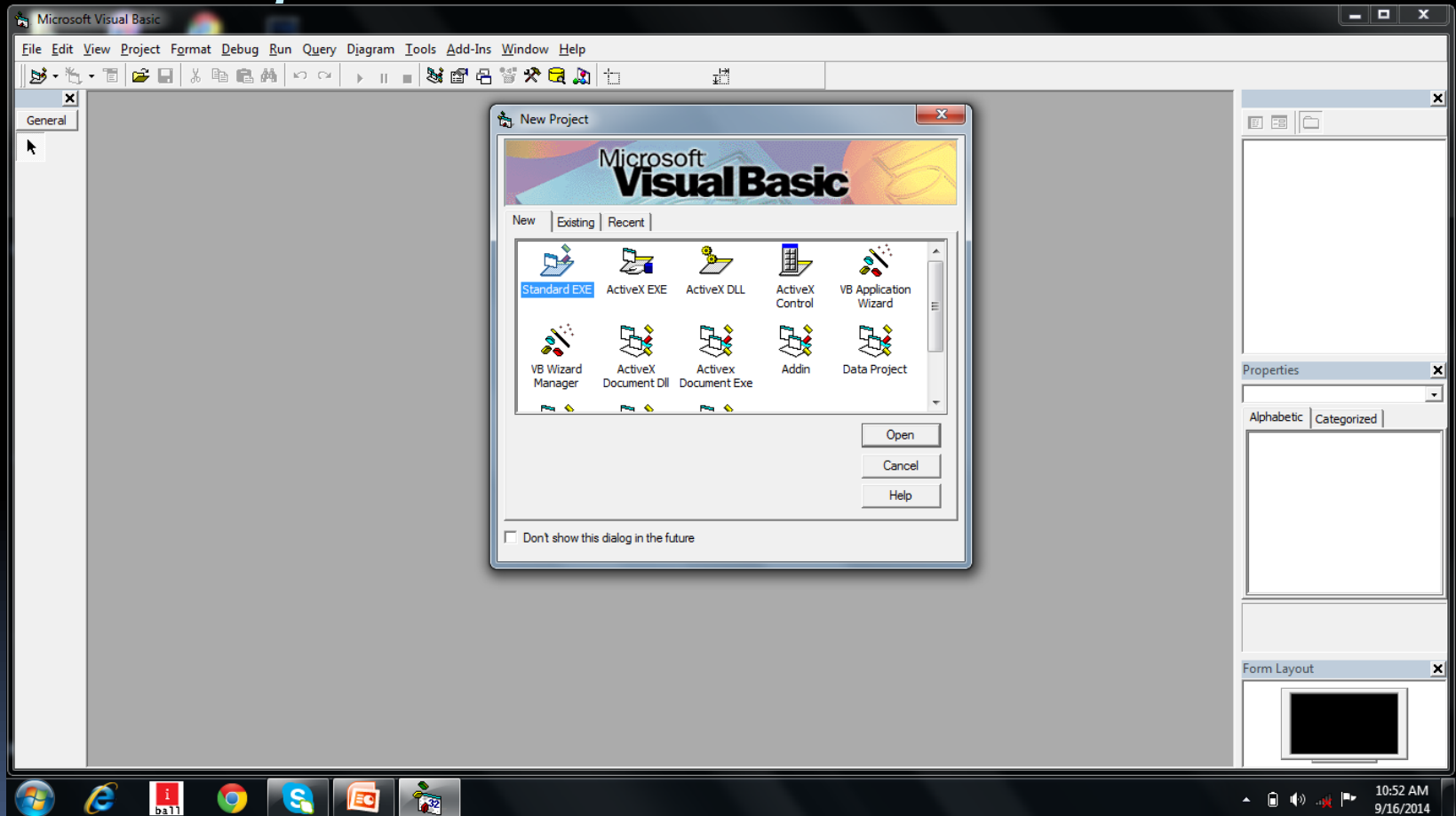
# Visual Basic 6.0 Window



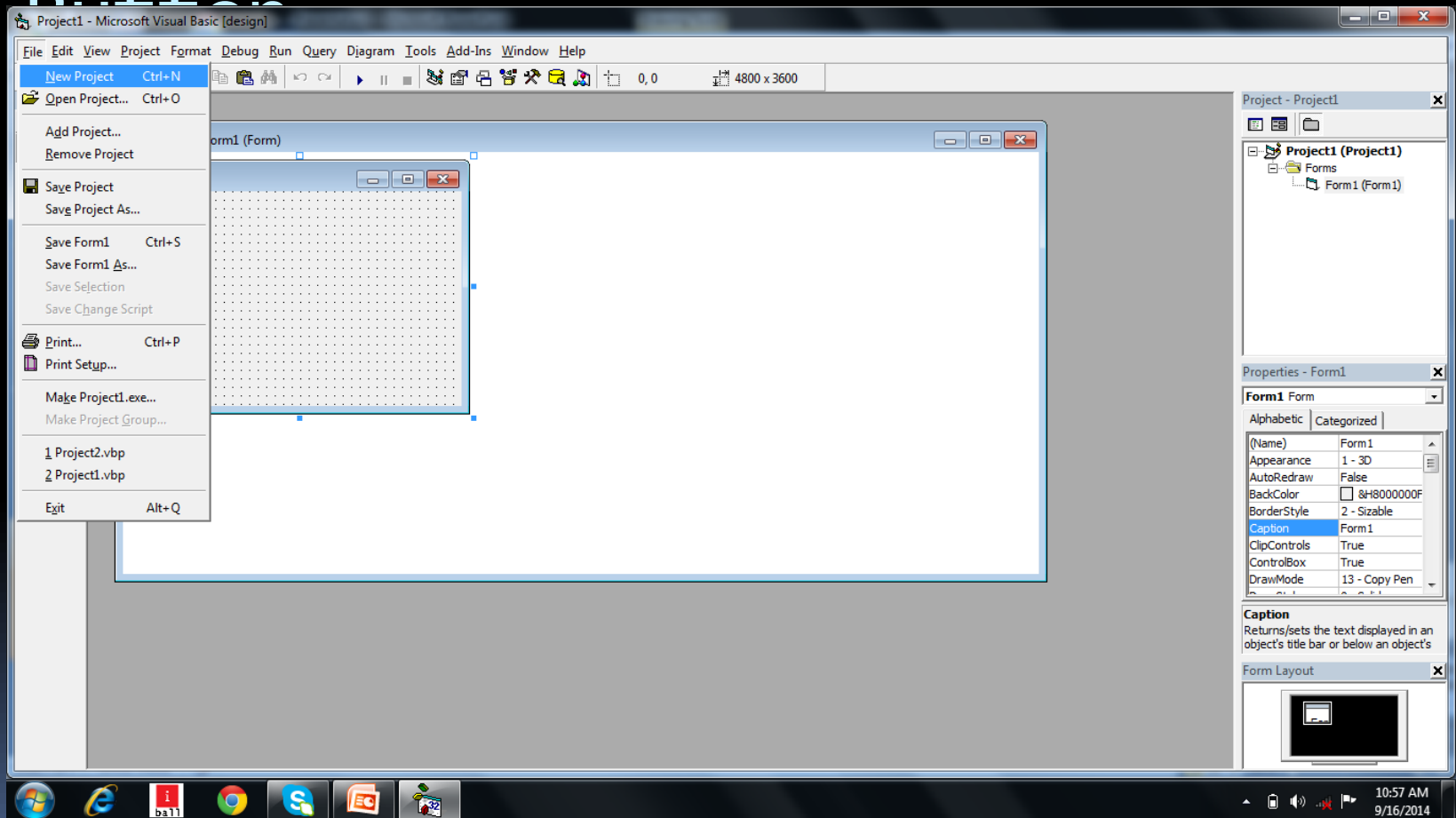
# Procedure for new project
