6.1.2 - The effective leadership is visible in various institutional practices such as decentralization and participative management.

The President, Executive Members, Principal, Heads of Departments, Teaching and Non -Teaching Staff, Alumni, Parents, Students and Representatives from the field of Education, Community, Research and Academic Experts are given scope and some participate directly in taking the decision for the academic and the infrastructural development of college i.e. Executive Council, CDC, IQAC, College Construction Committee, College Staff Council and Student Council. According to the Maharashtra Public Universities Act 2016, the Local Managing Committee has

been replaced by CDC. Members from the executive committee, expert from the field of education, research, society, industries, teaching, non-teaching staff and students are represented on this committee. CDC prepares an overall comprehensive development plan of the college regarding academic, administrative and infrastructural growth. The Principal is the executive head of the institution. He is authorized to take decisions regarding academic, administrative and financial matters in accordance with the policy decision decided by the CDC. The IQAC is headed by the Principal and the Coordinator who is selected from the faculty members to look after its activities. The management, representatives, teaching, non-teaching members, social activists, alumni and students are the members of IQAC who work for quality parameters in various academic and administrative activities.

- * Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for onward submission to NAAC based on the quality parameters.


Strategies:

Being an affiliated college of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati, our college follows the rules and regulations laid down by the UGC, Govt. of Maharashtra, and the affiliating parent university. 6.4.3 - Institutional strategies for mobilization of funds and the optimal utilization of resources.

The institution mobilizes funds for its regular activities and development from different agencies and individuals. The mobilized fund is optimally used by the institution. IQAC plays a key role in mobilizing the financial resources efficiently. It identifies the programmes and the funding source and plans accordingly. IQAC assesses the area for fund utilization based on the research policy, quality policy and strategic plans of the institution and gives recommendations to the CDC. Besides this, IQAC is vigilant on the announcement of different government funding agencies, regarding their schemes and educates and equips the faculty to proceed for specific funding in research and development. The institution has a well-defined mechanism for proper mobilization of funds that ensures transparency and the best use of it. The institution has a Governing Body, CDC, Planning and Purchase Committee, Library and various associated bodies which help in the preparation, division, allocation and utilization of funds. UGC funds are deposited in a separate account. The utilization of these funds is ensured through audit at the end of each financial year. Fees received from students are used for development of the institution, non-grant faculty and staff salaries are properly audited. Physical and Academic facilities are augmented as per need for students. Library services and Sports services are strengthened. Laboratories are augmented and IT infrastructure is increased.

6.5 - Internal Quality Assurance System

6.5.1 - Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has contributed significantly for institutionalizing the quality assurance strategies and processes

Institution has a rich culture of institutional functioning through participation among all stakeholders. The IQAC plays an important role in ensuring quality of the functioning of administrative and academic units of the institution. In order to make the students aware of the current and futuristic challenges and opportunities, the teaching faculty is encouraged and motivated to develop a scientific temper so as to propagate a research culture amongst the students. This is achieved by constantly sharing new research findings in their respective fields with the teachers and students. The two practices institutionalized by IQAC are: 1. Research Promotion Cell (RPC) 2. Streamlining of Administration Research Promotion Cell IQAC encourages and motivates Teachers and Students to actively participate in research activities. It recognizes the significance of promoting a research environment amongst staff and students. To this end, IQAC has established a Research Promotion Cell. It is run by a committee, comprising the Principal and senior teachers from various departments. The main thrust of RPC is towards: Helping the interested teachers in writing research project proposals and publishing the research works by attending and conducting Research Methodology workshops. Providing the latest

information about the quality journals of Scopus and UGC Care list and encouraging them to publish prolifically. Initiating research projects undertaken by students and mentored by teachers. Attending and conducting FDP to bridge the knowledge gap of the teachers at par with the latest developments in the irrespective disciplines.

6.5.2 - The institution reviews its teaching learning process, structures & methodologies of operations and learning outcomes at periodic intervals through IQAC set up as per norms and recorded the incremental improvement in various activities.

1. The IQAC conducted meetings with the Faculty Members, Heads of the departments, In charge of Internal Examination Committee throughout the academic year. 2. It encouraged the faculty co- ordination. 3. Committee conducted an academic plan and reviewed it time to time such as completion of curriculum, supervision of regular classes, attendance of the students, unit tests, assignments, seminars, group discussion, quiz, education tours and other activities. Important issues are discussed in the meetings with IQAC. 4. Insisted on new teaching methods and ICT use. For ICT based teaching, IQAC recommended the essential academic and infrastructural facilities to the College Development Committee. 5. This initiative of IQAC has been evolved into successful review methodology for improvement in teaching and learning process. Through this system of review, the IQAC observed the continuous development of teaching- learning process. 6. IQAC interacted with teachers and students regarding the changes in the curriculum, new teaching methods and ICT use. The use of ICT tools has become an integral part in teaching -learning process. In this way IQAC always encouraged teachers to utilize these tools in academic and laboratories. 7. Organized one day national seminar, conference, internal skill development workshop. 8. The focus is shifted to educational use of social media has also been utilized to establish communication with the students and peers. In teaching and learning, the feedback system is implemented to take the review of reliability and applicability.
